

Pat Lehman Legacy Award

The Pat Lehman Legacy Award would be an annual award given to a former supervisor who had served for at least 24 years on his or her local conservation district board.

Other criteria for favorable consideration:

- Held the office of chairperson
- Regularly attended KACD annual conventions
- Served as chairperson of or served on a KACD committee
- Served an active role in conservation activities at the state and local level
- Demonstrated leadership in promoting conservation in Kansas

Nominations would be made by members of the KACD Board of Directors (with input from local districts in each area). The Pat Lehman Legacy Award recipient would be selected by board vote and notified prior to the annual convention (around the first of November) so that individual can be invited to attend the entire convention as KACD's guest and receive the award at the annual awards banquet.

Funds donated to the KACD Endowment Fund in Pat Lehman's memory would be used to cover the following expenses each year:

- Convention registration bundle for award recipient
- Hotel room for Monday night
- Plaque

Nominations will be submitted in a one page narrative form to include an explanation of all criteria that pertains to the nominee. Nominations can be sent to the KACD Area Director or to James Krueger, KACD Executive Director at jimkrueger222@gmail.com by October 21, 2016.
