

KANSAS BANKERS ASSOCIATION AWARD CRITERIA

Water Conservation

- o Adoption of improved irrigation management techniques, such as irrigation scheduling, system improvement, and remote monitoring and/or control
- o Adoption of cropping systems to match irrigation system capacities
- o Adoption of appropriate tillage systems to reduce soil water evaporation and improve soil water storage from precipitation
- o Evidence of field tests for the evaluation of irrigation system performance
- o Submission of crop water budgets that track soil water levels, irrigation applications and rainfall events and yield performance
- o Improvement and/or development of on-farm or ranch water supplies

This program is sponsored by the Kansas Bankers Association and promoted by the K-State Research and Extension, Kansas Wild Parks, and Tourism, as well as Conservation Districts around the State. Nominations can be made by any person in the county. They should be sent to the Lane County Conservation District or K-State Research and Extension.
