

KANSAS BANKERS ASSOCIATION AWARD CRITERIA

Windbreak Recognition Program

- Provides protection from damaging winds for residential areas, livestock, or fields
- The original windbreak must consist of planted trees or shrubs. Volunteer trees/shrubs may be utilized to increase density, fill in gaps, or otherwise supplement the original planted trees and shrubs
- Plants must be managed and in healthy condition with no significant gaps in the windbreaks
- Windbreak location, density, and length must be adequate to provide the desired protection
- Windbreaks should be a minimum of three years old

This program is sponsored by the Kansas Bankers Association and promoted by the K-State Research and Extension, Kansas Wild Parks, and Tourism, as well as Conservation Districts around the State. Nominations can be made by any person in the county. They should be sent to the Lane County Conservation District or K-State Research and Extension.
